#### ARTISTIC SHORT CIRCUITS \_OBJECTIVES



Develop the use of low-carbon travel modes for artists (such as train, instead of travel by air).



Enable international programming at environmentally acceptable costs.



Improve the territorial anchoring of events:



Bottom-up logic:

by allowing emerging local artists to have easier access to the events that are part of their local community to make them a real showcase of the local scene.



**Downward logic:** 

by facilitating the transfer of knowledge and skills between visiting artists and local cultural actors.




Promote **cooperation** and professional structuring of sectors of the music industry as they work towards an ecological transition.



Improve the working conditions and well-being of artists (slow down the pace and improve the quality of tours, reduce psycho-social risks, etc.)

#### ARTISTIC SHORT CIRCUITS A SIMPLE STATEMENT





-25%

It is possible to reduce the carbon footprint of artists by 25% without changing programming practices, simply by working on mobility. \*\*

### \$ 1430

The additional travel time to reach that 25% reduction in CO2 emissions is only 1.5 hours per trip on average.\*\*

The model of artistic short circuits makes it possible to divide the carbon footprint of artists by 6.\*\*

Interested structures: consultants, festivals, labels, collectives, bookers, tour operators, researchers, etc. An important network ready to commit itself to move the lines.




# ORGANIZATION OF AN EXPERIMENTAL TOUR WITH EUROPEAN ARTISTS


